Graphic Communications/Print Shop Safety

- 1. Pay attention at all times when in the shop area and especially around moving machinery.
- 2. Use all safety guards and switches when operating machinery.
- 3. If you do not fully understand the operation of a piece of equipment, DO NOT TOUCH IT! Starting a piece of equipment can cause serious harm to the equipment and to yourself and others in the area.
- 4. **Never touch a press or piece of equipment someone else is working on**. There is to be NO HORSEPLAY in the shop.
- 5. Tell people in the vicinity before starting a press or other machine. Sound Horn if one is provided.
- 6. When operating equipment:
 - A. Roll up sleeves
 - B. Secure loose clothing
 - C. Wear safety shoes
 - D. Do not wear rings, ties or other jewelry
 - E. Wear safety glasses and/or ear plugs where necessary
- 7. Watch your hair. If it is long, tie it up or wear a hat.
- 8. Shut off the equipment when making adjustments, clearing jam ups, etc.
- 9. No more than one person near the cutter at ANY TIME!
- 10. Know where the fire extinguishers and fire blankets are located.
- 11. Know where the emergency shut down switches are located.
- 12. Drugs and machinery do not mix. Consult your doctor and inform your instructors before operating machinery if you are taking prescription medications.
- 13. Be careful with press room chemicals. Protect your eyes. Be especially careful with squeeze bottles.
- 14. Clean up all spills. Always watch where you are walking.
- 15. Keep rags that are used with SOLVENTS in a safety can.
- 16. Smoking, or any type of flame or spark, is strictly prohibited in the shop.
