The following are True / False questions:		
	1.	You should never work alone in the Shop.
	2.	Only severe injuries need to be reported to the instructor.
	3.	Always mix chemicals at an arm's length.
	4.	Always wear safety glasses or shield when pouring or mixing chemicals.
	5.	Wear safety glasses over prescription glasses where necessary.
	6.	When working in the shop, remove jewelry and obstructive clothing.
	7.	The paper cutter should be operated by two or more people.
	8.	The Safety Manual should be understood before starting work in the shop
	9.	When you leave your equipment for short periods, leave it running.
	10.	If you find an unlabeled container, dump it in the sink.
	11.	Prop open the lid to the safety container to let the vapors escape.
	12.	Wearing gloves when handling chemicals can prevent skin infections.
	13	Hands can be cleaned using press solvents
